What is Superstars Footy?

Superstars Footy is a Development Program (not a competition) for kids in the 5-7 age groups. The program is an extension of NAB AFL Auskick, where participants play game based activities leading into modified (non-contact) AFL matches. No extra mid-week training is required, just a one-hour session per week.

Participant Age Groups

All participants must be born within the age groups of 1/1/2011 - 31/12/2013 for the 2018 season. As this is a program, not a competition we do not accept playing up or down consent forms.

What is included in the \$75 State Registration Fee?

The state registration fee includes -

- Insurance
- Registration under AFL Queensland
- A participant pack (AFL Club themed)
- A 2018 NAB AFL Auskick membership in which they can participate in any of the Auskick programs at their club, or alternatively at a school venue.

If the child HAS NOT participated in Auskick in this calendar year, do they need to?

No, they do not have to participate in Auskick in the calendar year, however they must pay the State Registration Fee of \$75 plus your clubs Fee to participate.

This State Registration Fee covers participants for insurance.

If the child HAS participated in Auskick in this calendar year, do they have to play again this year?

No, however if they would like to participate again they're more than welcomed too.

Can a participant use the 'Get Started Voucher'?

These can be accepted; however, they are not built into the registration form. If a family wishes to use one, please take a manual registration & physically take the voucher from the family to claim it later as per the usual claim process. Clubs are then required to update the database to reflect this participant as 'paid'.

Does AFL Queensland Run Coaching Courses for this program?

Yes. Local Development Coordinators will work with clubs to offer at least one FREE coaching course within your region to upskill parents who have volunteered their time to coach this season.

Typically, these courses will take place within the month of March prior to the Superstars season kicking off. Coaches who attend these courses will also receive a branded Lanyard as well as a hardcopy of our Coaching Handbook

What other resources will AFL Queensland provide and how do I access them?

We will assist the club with various aspects of the program including but not limited too; promotional support, coach education, registration enquiries and on the ground support, including regular check ins and mid-year entry points.
